The proposed consultancy will contribute to developing a robust "Request for Proposal" for PSS and assist Lao Airlines during the selection, negotiation, and implementation stages to improve the airline's profitability and customer service.

Individual consultants with relevant qualifications and experience are invited to express their interest in providing the services. The successful candidate shall have:

- A Bachelor of Science or Engineering Degree is required.
- At least 10 years of international experience in airlines reservations and distribution systems, or in airline reservation systems development companies.
- Experience in airlines PSS and familiarity with various PSS software and technology solutions.
- Ability to assess and evaluate the technical aspects of PSS, including integration and scalability.
- In-depth knowledge of travel and airline industry, including trends, regulations, and IATA requirements regarding e-tickets regulations.
- Proficiency in procurement processes, including strategic sourcing and supplier management.
- Experience in airlines advisory to senior management
- Experience in capacity building and training.
