The Lao People's Democratic Republic (Lao PDR) has received a Loan from the ADB towards the cost of the Water Supply and Sanitation Improvement Sector Project (the Project), which will include the implementation of water supply systems, sanitation improvements in about 09 towns in 05 Provinces. A Project Management Unit (PMU) has been established within the DWS of the MPWT to coordinate and monitor all Project activities. One vital aspect of its function is to develop and maintain a set of Project coordination covering all activities. Part of the Loan will be used to finance eligible payments for the services provided by the Project Coordination.

The DWS, MPWT now invites expressions of interest from nationals of Lao PDR for the provision of consulting services for the Project coordination of all Project-related activities. The total input is 60 person-months from February 2026 to 31 December 2030.

Interested Consultants should provide information (CV, EOI, Other supporting documents, if any) demonstrating that S/he has the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Service. In order to qualify for this position, the candidates shall meet the following experience and competence requirements:

- At least a bachelor's degree in civil engineering, water/environmental engineering, or other relevant disciplines. Additional degree in economics, business administration or similar is an advantage.
- At least 8 years of relevant work experience as Project Coordinator or similar positions with major donor funded projects, i.e., Asian Development Bank (ADB).
- Experience in contract management of water supply and sanitation projects, including improvements and operations & maintenances will be an advantage.
- Knowledge, skills and experience in results-based planning, quality control, monitoring and evaluation or human resources management, ideally within the infrastructure sector, will be an advantage.
- Experience in procurement under projects financed by development partners (e.g. WB, ADB, etc).
- Good knowledge of spoken and written English and Good communication skills.
- Good computer literacy in Engineering software (e.g. AutoCAD/Sketchup, AirGIS) and Microsoft office (e.g., Word, Excel, PowerPoint).
- Willingness to travel as needed.
- Flexibility and ability to work and deliver high-quality production time.

The selection process will be in accordance with ADB's *Guidelines on the Use of Consultants by Asian Development Bank and its Borrowers, March 2013*, under Individual Consultant Selection Method.
