The National Intensive Specific Professional Trainer will report directly to the PDM office on day-to-day training activities and progress. Overall supervision and contract oversight will be provided by the PCU Project Manager, who will review and approve all deliverables prior to payment.

Minimum Qualification Requirements

The National Intensive Specific Professional Trainers should have the following qualifications and competencies:

- At least a Bachelor's degree in Food Science, Food Technology, Food Engineering, or a related field is required. A Master's degree is also preferred.
- At least 7–10 years' experience in food processing, food production, or a closely related field.
- Proficiency in Lao is required; working knowledge of English is preferred.
- Good working knowledge of computer programs such as Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.

The successful candidate will sign his/her contract with PCU within 20 working days of selection. Interested candidates should submit a written application with CV, copies of certificates, references, and the financial proposal to the address below no later than 22 May 2026.
