1. The **Lao People's Democratic Republic** has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Loan 4511-LAO: Water Supply and Sanitation Improvement Sector Project** Part of this financing will be used for payments under the Contract named above. Bidding is open to bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The **Ministry of Public Works and Transport** ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the construction and completion of **CW-03 Construction of Water Supply – Hom District, Xaisomboun Province** ("the Works").

The Works cover Water Supply – Hom District, Xaisomboun Province, three (3) villages: Homthat, Namkhien, and Phalavek, and include the following key components:

- Construction of water intake structures;
- Installation of raw water transmission pipelines about **3.3 km** and treated water distribution pipelines about **52 km**;
- Construction of foundations for water treatment plant facilities (2,000 m³/day), including associated building, and ancillary structures;
- Provision and installation of household water connections (1,250 sets); and
- Execution of all related civil, mechanical, and electrical works necessary for the complete and function operation of the system.
- The supply and installation of the Compact Water Treatment Plant (WTP) System are not included in the scope of this Contract and will be procured under a separate contract.

The estimated contract value is approximately **\$ 2,600,000, inclusive of all applicable taxes**. The contract duration is **eighteen (18) months** from the commencement date.

3. Open competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with **A Single Stage: One-Envelope** procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications defined in the Bidding Document may participate in this bidding:
 - The Bidder shall demonstrate that nonperformance of a contract due to contractor default has not occurred since 1 January 2023, as defined in the Bidding Document.

- The Bidder shall submit audited financial statements or, if not required by the law of the Bidder's country, other financial statements accepted by the Employer, for the last three (3) years to demonstrate the current soundness of the Bidder's financial position. As a minimum, the Bidder's net worth for the latest year, calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities, shall be positive.
- The Bidder shall demonstrate a minimum average annual construction turnover of **\$ 3,466,667**, calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years.
- The Bidder shall demonstrate that its financial resources, less its financial obligations for its current contract commitments, **meet or exceed \$ 433,334** for the subject contract. Evidence shall be provided in accordance with the requirements of the Bidding Document.
- The Bidder shall have participated as a contractor, Joint Venture partner, or subcontractor in at least two (2) contracts of similar size, **each with minimum value of \$ 2,080,000**, that have been satisfactorily completed between 1 January 2016 and the bid submission deadline.
- The Bidder shall demonstrate participation and successful implementation as a contractor, Joint Venture partner, or subcontractor, within the last ten (10) years, in at least one (1) contract similar technical nature involving district-level water supply systems in a similar environment to the project site such as mountainous terrain, rural community and area, including water intake and source development, water treatment facilities ($\geq 1,000 \text{ m}^3/\text{day}$), transmission and distribution pipelines laying, construction of water storage structures ($\geq 100 \text{ m}^3$), service connections and network appurtenances (≥ 100 connection), auxiliary buildings and supporting facilities ($\text{GFA} \geq 200 \text{ m}^2$) with associated MEP works, testing and commissioning, and implementation of environmental, social, health, and safety (ESHS) measures.
- Compliance with the above experience requirements shall be demonstrated through signed contract agreements, taking-over certificates, completion certificates, interim payment certificates, and/or other documentary evidence acceptable to the Employer.
- In the case of a Joint Venture, all partners shall meet the eligibility requirements as specified in the Bidding Document. Qualification requirements shall be assessed in accordance with the Joint Venture provisions specified in Section 3, Evaluation and Qualification Criteria, of the Bidding Document.

The qualification criteria are more completely described in Section 3 (Evaluation and Qualification Criteria) of the Bidding Document.
