The Government of Lao People's Democratic Republic has received financing through a credit from the World Bank Loan and a grant from PROBLUE Trust Fund toward the cost of the "Lao PDR Pollution and Waste Management Project (PWMP)" for the duration of six years from September 2025 to September 2031 and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services described below.

The consulting services ("the Services") is to support the PWMP in the day-to-day financial management and bookkeeping of the project, monitor expenditures and advances, ensuring compliance with approved budgets and financial procedures, and maintaining complete supporting documentation for the implementing department under PWMP. Consultant will be work in close collaboration with the National Financial Management Consultant, PMU and other implementing agencies. This shall be a full-time, time-based contract. The total estimated inputs for this assignment will be 24 months with possible annual renewal subjected to availability of funds, requirement of the Project and annual satisfactory performance evaluations. The Consultant is expected to commence the assignment as soon as possible. The Terms of Reference (TOR) for the primary procurement stage for the assignment can be obtained at the address given below.

The Department of Housing and Urban Planning (DHUP-MPWT) now invites eligible individual consultants to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultant should provide information (CV, Expression of Interest, other supporting information, if any) demonstrating that s/he has the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. To qualify for this position, the candidates shall meet the following experience and competence requirements:

- At least 5 years' experience in accounting. Experience in similar position will be a plus
- Experience working with major donor funded projects, particularly with World Bank or ADB funded projects, will be an advantage
- Good knowledge of spoken and written English
- Good computer literacy in Microsoft office (e.g., Word, Excel, PowerPoint), internet and email access and experience in using accounting software (Sage 300 ERP).

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" dated February 2025 ("Procurement Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Competitive Selection of Individual Consultants method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
